The Feast of the Holy Trinity

On the cover of today's Liturgy Booklet, we have a photo of the famous Russian icon of the Holy Trinity, depicted as the three angels who were offered hospitality by Abraham and Sarah (Gen.18:1-8)

It is a great icon, written by Andrei Rublev (15th century), a copy of which we have to the side of the Nave Altar at Christ Church.

In one of his books, the late Henri Nouwen wrote, "Rublev wrote this Icon not only to share the fruits of meditation on the Mystery of the Holy Trinity but also to offer his fellow monks a way to keep their hearts centered in God while living in the midst of political unrest."

We certainly know that experience today.

Nouwen goes on to say: "Within the circle of the Holy Trinity, all true knowledge descends into the heart. The Russian mystics describe prayer as descending with the mind into the heart and standing there in the presence of God. Prayer takes place where heart speaks to heart, that is, where the heart of God is united with the heart that prays. Thus, knowing God becomes loving God, just as being known by God is being loved by God."

In 2018, Pope Francis wrote: "The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity leads us to contemplate the Mystery of God who unceasingly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and through love."

LIVING WITH COVID-19

"The most recent advice from the Diocese: Easing restrictions

" In practice most Churches and Church activities are free of restrictions, we continue to echo the health advice to maintain good hygiene and care, use sanitiser and not attend if you have any symptoms.

Any worker on Church premises including volunteers must be double vaccinated.

From midnight on 22nd April anyone can attend Church services regardless of their vaccine status.

Food and drink may also be be made available and those serving are not required to wear masks.

CHURCH FINANCES:

Due to the Parish's difficult financial situation, as advised at the Annual Meeting, the wardens are keeping a close eye on parish receipts and expenditure. The wonderful thing is the response from our small congregation. The Fundraising Committee was given a very big target to achieve for the year (\$12,000) and is doing a spectacular job. It has raised close to \$9000 to date. A huge vote of thanks goes to Robyn Foy (convenor) and her band of hard-working helpers. Parishioners have also risen to the challenge in meeting the large increase in expected giving via the plate so that we are, for April, \$2889 above the increased target figure. There is, however, no room for complacency as the May figure is below target due to illness of parishioners and

absence of some people. We do ask that, if you are unable to attend Church, you cover your usual giving as soon as possible. We also say THANK YOU for your response to date. Another fantastic effort! Our costs are constantly rising and we have had big increases in insurance costs, parish assessment to the Diocese and the inevitable costs for minor and major maintenance. We still face a deficit for the year. Several parishioners have made donations to cover costs and we do also thank them for their wonderful help.
